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## Objectives

1. To gain a understanding of the various historical events of the United States
2. To discern God's providence in the seven eras of the U.S. History

## Homework

1. All homework should be done neatly on non-spiral paper. Illegible homework will be recopied.
2. A zero will be given if homework is late. Depending on the nature of the assignment, a student may sometimes be required to complete a homework assignment even if he did not turn it in on time and received a zero. In addition to the academic penalty, demerits will be given for every **three** assignments that are late.
3. Projects must be turned in on time. Late projects will receive a deduction of one letter grade for each day late. Most projects will count as one test grade.
4. It is the student's responsibility to obtain make-up work due to an absence. Students will receive the number days they were absent, plus an extra day to make up assignments. **If material for a quiz, test, or assignment was presented or announced before an absence, the student must turn in the project/assignment or take the quiz/test his first day back to school.**
5. Assignments will be posted daily on my webpage. However, if any discrepancy arises, the information that was communicated in class will stand.

## Tests

1. Tests will cover textbook readings, classroom discussions, and notes in class.

## Quizzes

1. Both announced and unannounced quizzes will be given.
2. Some writing assignments may be counted as a quiz grade.

- 10% Homework

## Classroom Procedures

1. Sit in assigned seats.
2. Have materials ready to begin class. Homework ready to be turned in.
